Austin Wastewater Treatment (Texas, USA)



This project takes raw water from Lake Travis and connects it to a pump station via a 9-ft finished diameter tunnel. From this station, raw water is pumped up to the water treatment facility. The Jollyville transmission main was tunneled and includes approximately 36,300 lf of 84-in pipe.

Red Hill Underground Fuel Storage Facility (Hawaii, USA)



The Red Hill project is the primary fuel depot for the United States Navy's Pacific Fleet. Diesel fuel flows by gravity through a 32-inch pipeline and jet fuel flows through 16- and 18-inch pipelines through the Red Hill tunnels to Pearl Harbor.

Neelum-Jhelum Hydropower Project (Muzaffarabad, Pakistan)



This project involves a 184-ft-high concrete gravity dam on the Neelum River to divert water through a 17.7-mile-long headrace tunnel system to an underground 4-unit power station designed to generate 970-MW of electricity. The headrace tunnel crosses under a major river and passes through a seismically active fault.
